Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries accompanied by the incorrect fees or a returned check do **NOT** constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those whose checks are returned for insufficient funds will be handled on a cash-only basis for all future trials.

Mixed Breed Entries. Those entering Obedience or Rally trials with a mixed breed dog should indicate their breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." The sire and dam information shall remain blank for mixed-breed entrants.

REFUNDS

Bitches in season are absolutely NOT allowed anywhere on trial grounds. NO Exceptions. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per entry per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the judge or veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

Refunds for cancellations due to judge change, overpayment of entries or cancellations made prior to the closing date will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent after the trials.

Beartooth Agility Club of Montana (BACM) may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against BACM or official thereof.

TRANSFERS

A transfer (from one obedience class to another obedience class; or a rally class to another rally class) may be requested of the Trial Secretary if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible. Provided the class and judge are available, a transfer can be made

without requirements of a title being met. The request must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Chapter 1, Section 16A, obedience and Chapter 1, Section 16, rally.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Per AKC Rules and Regulations this trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registered breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number or AKC Canine Partners. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind are not eligible. Dogs that are deaf are now eligible to enter obedience and rally trials. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to enter. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Puppies 4 to 6 months old are now eligible to be on show grounds due to the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition. Mixed breeds that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

SHOE POLICY for the NEW TURF

For those who are competing in the Rally Ring and for those who will be crating their dogs on the agility turf, please read this information carefully.

No muddy, wet or dirty shoes are allowed on the turf. We suggest you have a set of clean and dry shoes set aside for wearing on the turf and in the Rally Ring. When you are going outside, please wear your outside shoes. You do not need to remove or change your shoes as soon as you enter the building. The entry mats and black mats are there to collect most of the outside dirt and mud. However, we do ask that you change into dry and clean shoes before walking on the turf both inside the Rally Ring and outside it.

Most judges are not allowing you to compete in socks, so having a clean pair of shoes is important if you're competing in Rally.

Some people use overshoes or boots when you go outside to potty your dogs. Then you can slip off the overshoes when you enter the turf area. YDS has paper booties also; however, these booties wear out after one or two outings in mud or snow.

The new turf is very nice and we want to keep it that way for a long time. YDS appreciates your cooperation in wearing only clean and dry shoes on the turf.

One last thing; Please be sure to POTTY YOUR DOG BEFORE YOU ENTER THE COMPETITION RING!
A \$10 "accident" fee will apply.
