This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP prefix), an AKC Canine Partners listing (MA prefix) or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs entered should be physically sound. Not eligible are dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form.

Entry Fees and Information for Entering

Online Entries may be made via the AKC online entry system.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 100; Paper entries 250.
